Shaped by the Landscape

A Rockport home set embraces views and the outdoors

Set on a ledge of blueberries on the Southwestern Flank of Spring Mountain Highlands, this house designed by Eric Beckström embraces southwesterly views. The layout follows the shape of an existing ledge outcropping and allows views of the rolling landscape on the edge of this bluff. The materials are classic Maine style with cedar shingles, open wood porches, and decks with oversized windows to allow a connection to the outdoors with distant views to Penobscot Bay. The interior will feature wood floors, slate tile, and a gas stove. The existing tree canopy of mixed hardwoods and spruce/fir will shelter the north and east sides.
